The Illinois Early Learning Standard Benchmarks guide our curriculum. The State Goals are:

- **Language Arts**

Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing.

- **Mathematics**

Sense of Numbers, Identification of Relationships in Objects, Concepts of Geometry, and Analysis of Data Information.

- **Science**
