Educational Child Care

Kiddie Kollege was established in 1996 to meet the child care needs of Wayne County, IL. Since its inception, Kiddie Kollege has grown into a full service early childhood education center offering high quality educational services for young children ages birth to twelve years of age.

The center is licensed by the Illinois Dept. of Children and Family Services and is accredited through the National Early Childhood Program Accreditation Association. Our staff receive training in various educational applications on a yearly basis. The social, emotional and physical needs of each child is the focus of our curriculum and activities.



The program is staffed by our Administrator, Jill Andrews, Ph.D., Director, Linda Bopp, A.S.E.C. and Assistant Director, Angie Lane, A.S.E.C. The child care program is offered on a year round basis and is open Monday through Friday each week from 6:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m.

Our Parent Handbook provides additional information regarding the child care program. Our site contract with Illinois Dept of Human Services provides financial assistance based on income.

Infant formula, baby food and cereal are provided at no charge.

ISBE PREKINDERGARTEN

Children ages three to five are screened for admission into our state prekindergarten program. This program is offered in two sections—am/pm for 2.5 hours. The Creative Curriculum is implemented by our pre-k teacher, Mrs. Dawna Simpson, B.S.E.C.. Family Fun Nights and a parent lending library are other services offered in this program. This is a free program supported through a grant from the Illinois State Board of Education.

WAYNE COUNTY FAMILY ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

This program is for parents with children ages birth to three. Expectant mothers and teen parents are also provided services. Children are screened for developmental levels. Services include: Pre/Post Natal Care; Parent/Child Playgroups; Home Visits; Family Involvement and Fun Nights and parent educational workshops/training. A Birth-to-Three Parent Lending Library is also available for parents. This program is made possible through a grant from the Illinois State Board of

Education and a partnership with Fairfield Public School District #112 and Kiddie Kollege. This is a free program and serves 75 children per year. Family



Parents are their child's first and best teacher.

Support Specialists are located at Kiddie Kollege available to enroll children. Transportation is available to activities provided by the Family Enrichment Program.

EARLY INTERVENTION

Many early intervention therapists provide services on-site at Kiddie Kollege. These services include vision, hearing, developmental, occupational and speech therapy. All children ages birth-to-three are eligible for free screening. Children ages three-to-five are also eligible for screening services.



All children are eligible for services.

SCHOOL AGE

Both a before-school and after-school program are available for children ages five to twelve years. Various activities include computers, games, videos, homework assistance and outdoor play. Snacks are provided. The school age summer program activities include swimming, skating, movies, field trips and other educational activities kids love.
