Parent Guarantees for the Wobbler Room  
(Revised November 2015)**

**We promise that:**

1. We will help your child to improve upon his or her walking, talking, and eating table food skills.
2. We will document your child's milestones and share that information with you at the Parent Teacher conferences. We will also refer concerns your child may have to Early Intervention Specialists with written parental consent.
3. We will communicate with you any problems or concerns with food. We will encourage your child to taste various foods to ensure they are eating nutritiously.
4. We will teach your wobbler to learn all classmates and teacher's names; identification of animals and their sounds, parts of their bodies, and many objects in books.
5. We will teach your wobbler to eat with a spoon and learn to eat at a table, as well as learn table responsibilities such as helping to pass out milk, napkins, spoons, plates, etc.
6. We will help your child to learn socialization skills such as how to share with other children and take turns.
7. We will teach your child to say "please" and "thank you"; learn simple songs; learn to play with rhythm toys, and marching in step.
8. We will read to your child on a daily basis and encourage them to look at books on their own.
9. We will teach fine motor skills through puzzle and game playing; role playing is taught through use of dolls and block building.
10. We will maintain a loving atmosphere and use positive words to correct behavior.
11. We will always be sure that your child's nose is wiped and no food is on their face or hands.
12. Staff check children for sign that diapers/pull-ups are wet or contain feces at least every two hours when children are awake and when children awaken or on an as needed basis.
13. Diapers are changed when wet or soiled within five minutes of discovery.
14. Staff will have a hand on the child when the child is being changed on an elevated surface.
15. We will provide outdoor time on a daily basis – weather permitting.
16. We will disinfect all toys on a daily basis to help stop the spreading of germs. We will also use separate wash cloths and Kleenex tissues.
17. We will try to accommodate every parent to meet any special needs of their child.
18. We will have a health consultant visit the program on a monthly basis. We will implement corrections according to the recommendations of the health consultant.
19. Wobblers will not have bottles while on their cot.
20. Wobblers will not carry bottles, sippy cups, or regular cups with them while walking or crawling.
21. Teaching staff will offer children fluids from a cup as soon as the families and teachers decide together that a child is developmentally ready to use a cup.
22. We will follow DCFS and NAEYC accreditation guidelines.
23. We will have a health consultant visit the program on a monthly basis. We will implement corrections according to the recommendations of the health consultant.
24. Teaching staff will offer parent teacher conferences twice per year (October & March) and progress reports will be sent out January & July.
25. We will provide developmental screenings in October & March of each year or on an as needed basis and within 60 days of your child's enrollment.
26. Teaching staff will provide goals and objectives based on child's needs that are aligned with Illinois Early Learning Standards and implemented through "Creative Curriculum".
