Activities and Services:

Personal Visits are offered bi-weekly and provide information and activities to increase child development skills, as well as offer social support.

Parent/Child Groups are offered on a monthly basis and focus on social interaction and learning through play, art, books, and songs.

Parent Workshops are offered six times per year and are made of small groups that offer training on parent-centered topics and also allow parents to share their ideas, solutions, concerns, and support on various parenting topics. Researched based information is also shared.

Family Involvement and Fun Nights provide opportunities for parents and children to develop friendships and interact in community settings.

Our **Lending Library** provides a place to check out children books, toys, music CDs, and story sacks. Parenting books, magazines, and videos are also available.
